Flat Fee: \$90 per judge / per horse any rider or division.

***Rookie classes will be free with a \$50.00 office fee per horse and rider combination. **Cattle charges and AQHA drug fees not included in flat fee or free Rookie Classes.**

Canadian at Par for all shows in 2019. Horse must be registered in Canada and owner must have valid Canadian identification.

High Points & Reserve Awards for the 4-judge circuit:

Performance Horse and Working Horse awards in the following divisions: Open, Level 1 Amateur, Amateur, Select, Level 1 Youth, Youth 18 & Under. ****Must show in halter and 2 AQHA classes in your categories:** Working horse division categories: 1 (Halter), 2 (Ranch Riding, Reining & Working Cowhorse only), 6 (Roping & Cutting). Performance horse division categories: 1(Halter), 2(Ranch Riding, Western Riding & trail only), 4 (Over Fences), 5 (Western Pleasure, Pleasure Driving & Hunter Under Saddle) 7 (Showmanship, Horsemanship Equitation) to all 4 judges. Small Fry, Rookie Youth and Rookie Amateur awards will be awarded to the exhibitor with the highest number of points in the division and must show to all 4 judges. All awards will be determined as per AQHA 9 point rule.

Any owner or exhibitor, whose personal check (for show fees or stalls) fails to clear the bank for any reason, has 30 days to make the check good. If he or she fails to do so, points for that show will not count for year-end awards and could be subject to AQHA notification. There is a \$25.00 fee for each returned check.
